



CIRCULAR TO REGIONAL BODIES

INOCULATIONS AGAINST AFRICAN HORSE SICKNESS

As there appears to be some confusion regarding the method of administering the regulations controlling the inoculations against African Horse Sickness, we have set out below an explanation.

- 1 Horses inoculated, between 1 February and 30 June of any year must be re-inoculated by a registered veterinarian within a period of 12 months from the date of the inoculation otherwise the inoculation will be deemed to have expired.

- 2 Horses inoculated between 1 July and 31 January in any year must be re-inoculated by a registered veterinarian during the same period in the following year otherwise the inoculation will be deemed to have expired.

- 3 All inoculations must be recorded by the vet administering the inoculation and signed by him.

Please ensure that all of your judges and veterinary delegates are made aware of the above.
